**Billy Gowlland Memorial Squirrel Hunting Derby**  
**Saturday, January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010**

Nasa is a non-profit sportsmen's organization dedicated to helping the elderly and physically challenged in the greater La Crosse area gain access to the outdoors. All proceeds will be used to help nasa meet this objective.

- 1) The squirrel derby is a one day event that will be held **Saturday, January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010.**
- 2) **\*\*All hunters must pay a \$20 entry fee before the day of the derby. Entry fee increases to \$30 the day of the derby.** (see bottom of sheet) The entry fee covers cash prizes, dinner, and entry into the drawing for the .17 caliber "ultimate" squirrel rifle! **You must be present to win.**
- 3) Entry forms **must be in the mail NO LATER than Tuesday, January 26<sup>th</sup>** to be received on time. Call-ins are acceptable if past the mailing deadline.
- 4) Non-hunters may attend the dinner and banquet for \$10. Non-hunting youth 12 and under eat free.
- 5) **SO WE HAVE ENOUGH FOOD, please confirm the number of people in your party (see below).**
- 6) Hunt anywhere in North America for up to five (5) squirrels. Wisconsin gaming laws apply.
- 7) Bring your squirrels to the Badger State Sportsmen's Club (see map on page 2) and register your squirrels between 4:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Dinner will begin at 6:30 sharp. Cash bar available.
- 8) There will be games of chance and raffles for cash and prizes before and after dinner.
- 9) You will receive a phone call to verify your entry into the event, but you must check in at the banquet.
- 10) **Special thanks to the Badger States Sportsmen for donating the use of their facility, Coca Cola for providing beverages, and the Disciascio's for providing dinner for this event.**

To make the derby more competitive, fair, and fun for everyone involved, there will now be five (5) categories in which you can win. Hunters can combine squirrels to make a limit:

1. **ALL GREY:** All of the squirrels in your bag are Grey or Black in nature. No fox squirrels allowed.  
1<sup>st</sup>: \$75      2<sup>nd</sup>: \$50      3<sup>rd</sup>: \$25
  2. **ALL FOX / MIXED BAG:** All Fox squirrels, or any mix that includes Fox and Grey or Black.  
1<sup>st</sup>: \$75      2<sup>nd</sup>: \$50      3<sup>rd</sup>: \$25
  3. **LARGEST SINGLE SQUIRREL:** No explanation needed.  
a) Largest black/grey: \$25      b) Largest Fox: \$25
  4. **GREATEST NUMBER OF PINE SQUIRRELS:** \$25  
a) In case of a tie, the winner will be determined by the smallest total weight.
- \*\* Note: According to the DNR general office in Eau Claire, the "Pine" squirrel is an unprotected species with an unlimited limit.
5. **YOUTH HUNTERS:** In addition to the above categories, all registered youth hunters 16 and under will be entered into a drawing to win one of three, full-size .22 caliber rifles. All runner-ups will receive a special hunter's gift.

**OTHER RULES:**

1. Your squirrels will be checked and weighed by highly skilled judges. All decisions are final and are not subject to change.
2. Please be sporting: Rifles preferred. Donated squirrels to go to local food groups.
3. **There will be disqualifications** for each squirrel that has been:  
a. "doctored"      b. scraped off the road      c. pulled out of the freezer
