- 1) **All hunters must pay a \$20 entry fee before the day of the derby.** The entry fee covers cash prizes, dinner, and entry into the drawing for the "ultimate" squirrel rifle! **You must be present to win.**
- 2) Have your entry form **in the mail** no later than **Tuesday, January 24<sup>th</sup>** to be received on time.
- 3) Non-hunters may attend the dinner and banquet for \$10.00. Non-hunting youth 12 and under eat free.
- 4) **In order that we will have enough food**, please confirm the number of people in your party (see application below).
- 5) Bring your squirrels to the **Badger State Sportsmen's Club** (see map on page 2) and **register between 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.** Dinner will begin at 6:30 sharp. A cash bar will be available.
- 6) There will be games of chance and raffles for cash and prizes before and after dinner.
- 7) You will receive a phone call to verify your entry into the event, but **you must check in at the banquet.**
- 8) Special thanks to the **Badger States Sportsmen** for donating the use of their facility, and **Lou and Martha Disciascio** for providing dinner for this event.

## **RULES:**

**Every hunter will be entered into cash drawings no matter how many squirrels you get.**

There will be six buckets in the registration shed when you bring in your squirrels. You will receive one color-coded ticket for the number of squirrels you harvest (0 through 5), and we will draw three winners from each of the buckets. Payouts are as follows:

- 0 squirrels: Three winners @ \$20 ea.
- 1 squirrel: Three winners @ \$25 ea.
- 2 squirrels: Three winners @ \$30 ea.
- 3 squirrels: Three winners @ \$50 ea.
- 4 squirrels: Two winners @ \$75 ea.
- 5 squirrels: Two winners @ \$100 ea
- Single largest squirrel: Black/Grey = \$25 Fox = \$25
- Greatest number of pine squirrels: \$25 (Tie goes to lowest total weight)

**REGISTERED YOUTH HUNTERS:** In addition to the above categories, all registered youth hunters 16 and under will be entered into a drawing to win one of three, full-size .22 caliber rifles. All runner-ups will receive a special hunter's gift.
