- 5) Bring your squirrels to the *Badger State Sportsmen's Club* (see map on back) and **register between 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.** All hunters are entered to win cash prizes.
- 6) Dinner will available ala carte when you arrive. Cash bar available.
- 7) There will be games of chance and raffles for cash and prizes during the evening.
- 8) You will receive a phone call to verify your entry into the event, but **you must check in at the banquet.**

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RULES:

Every hunter will be entered into cash drawings no matter how many squirrels you get.

There will be six buckets in the registration shed when you bring in your squirrels. You will receive one color-coded ticket for the number of squirrels you harvest (0 through 5), and we will draw three winners from each of the buckets. Payouts are as follows:

0 squirrels: Three winners @ \$20 ea.

1 squirrel: Three winners @ \$25 ea.

2 squirrels: Three winners @ \$30 ea.

3 squirrels: Three winners @ \$50 ea.

4 squirrels: Two winners @ \$75 ea.

5 squirrels: Two winners @ \$100 ea

Single Largest Squirrel: Black/Grey = \$25 Fox = \$25

Greatest Number of Pine Squirrels: \$25 (Tie goes to lowest total weight)

REGISTERED YOUTH HUNTERS: In addition to the above categories, all registered youth hunters 16 and under will be entered into a drawing to win one of three, full-size .22 caliber rifles.
